

PRIVACY STATEMENT ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN:

EU DATA PROVIDERS SURVEY

1 Context

The European Union Satellite Centre (SatCen) processes the personal data of a natural person in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

This privacy notice explains SatCen's policies and practices regarding its collection and use of your personal data in the Consultation on the European Data Market, and sets forth your data protection rights.

3 Why does the SatCen process personal data?

The purpose of the processing is to consult EU Data provider operators on the EU data market, through a questionnaire. This consultation is conducted within the framework of the Pilot EOGS initiative implemented by SatCen.

In a first moment, EU Data provider operators are invited to submit information by email, in order to receive by email the questionnaire at a later stage.

4 What personal data does the SatCen process?

Data subjects submit the following data: Company Legal name, Business sector, Place of establishment, Ownership structure, direct or indirect control by a non-EU country or non-EU entity, Company Website, Contact Point, email address.

In addition, the SatCen processes any personal data that may be sent by email.

5 What are the legal bases for the processing?

The legal basis for the processing is Article 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725: the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.

The respondents are informed in the consultation announcement and in the survey that, by submitting their personal data by email, are consenting to the processing in the terms defined in the privacy statement.

6 Who has access to your personal data and to whom is it disclosed?

Personal data is not transferred to other recipients outside the SatCen Pilot EOGS Coordination activity.

7 For how long does the SatCen keep your data and how is it stored?

Participants' contact data are stored for a period of 5 years. Personal data is stored electronically on the servers of the SatCen, only accessible to the SatCen SatCen Pilot EOGS Team

8 What are your rights concerning your personal data?

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it.

You have the right to rectify your personal data.

Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use.

You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time.

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by using the contact details mentioned in this privacy statement. Please note that withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of any processing based on your consent before this consent is withdrawn.

The SatCen will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you.

In case you wish to verify which personal data is stored on your behalf by the SatCen, have it modified, corrected, or deleted, or restrict the processing, or object to it or to exercise the right to data portability, please send an explicit written request to contacts detailed below, using the Form provided in [SatCen - Privacy Notice \(europa.eu\)](https://europa.eu/satcen/privacy-notice).

Any correction of your personal data will be taken into consideration from the data protection point of view.

Your request will be answered without undue delay, and in any event within 1 month of receipt of the request. However, according to Article 14(3) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, this period may be extended by up to 2 months where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of requests. The SatCen will inform you of any such extension within 1 month of receipt of the request, together with the reasons for the delay.
